GO PEGASUS FOR BOSKALIS



This morning 24th April 2019 the 2013 built Deep Water Anchor Handling tug Go Pegasus (Imo 9495210), in Boskalis grey, was shifted from the Wilton harbor Schiedam to the Waalhaven in Rotterdam. The Boskalis logo's on the vessel are not placed/painted yet. The Go Pegasus will be taken over by Boskalis as per 1st May 2019 for a three years BareBoat charter with an option to buy. The vessel will be renamed Boka

Pegasus. The AHT shall carried out full DP trails under her current name, flag and classification society. Hereafter, 1st May, she will changed flag to Malta and classification society to Bureau Veritas. Her management go to BOTS – Antwerp (Boskalsis Offshore Transport Services). During her trails in Flekkefjord she performed a bollard pull of 257 tons. The vessel was built by PT Batamec Shipyard – Indonesia. She has a length o.a. of 91.00 mtrs a length b.p. of 79,35 mtrs a beam of 21.95 mtrs and a mouded depth of 9,56 mtrs. Her grt is 7,534 tons and dwt 3,681 tons. She has two Caterpillar Motoren GmbH & co MAK 16M32C (2 x 8000 kWt) + 2 x PTI Booster motors (2 x 1500 kWt). ME Power – 21440 BHP. Max power (booster mode) 25460 BHP. Her dynamic position system is from Kongsberg K-Pos DP-2. (*Photo: Leen van der Meijden*)
